

Returning HACC Students

NAKYSHA:

After logging in, you’ll be able to create a new application and update your personal information. We request that an official transcript be submitted if you have attended another institution since leaving HACC.

[The screen switches to show an example of what a welcome email from HACC looks like.]

NAKYSHA VOICEOVER:

You will receive your welcome email stating your next steps in three to five business days.

[The screen switches back to NAKYSHA.]

NAKYSHA:

Your myHACC account will be reactivated, and your next step will be to complete your FAFSA and meet with an academic advisor.

[A lower-third appears with the text “studentaid.gov.”]

NAKYSHA:

The FAFSA is the Free Application for Federal Student Aid and it determines if students are eligible to receive financial aid.

[A lower-third appears with the text “advising@hacc.edu,” which switches over to “1-800-ABC-HACC.”]
